


Accessing Imaging Facility Microscope using OpenIris

1) To access any system of the imaging facility through OpenIris you need a CDF mail

2) Type <http://iris.science-it.ch/> in your usual navigator, click on register and follow the procedure. Select the join group option and pick your correct team. Selecting a team is needed to book any system..

3) Using the same address, <http://iris.science-it.ch>, connect to the OpenIris interface to ask for a training, book a system, submit an issue... etc.


Go to the Scheduler page. You can personalize the systems you want to see on this page by using the locker button 

4) For most systems, you need to be trained to be allowed to book a session.

Training has to be asked online using the training button 

for the system you want to use. We'll contact you in the 7 days following your demand to propose a training appointment.

Do not hesitate to contact us : pf-microscopie.cirb@college-de-france.fr before asking for a training, if you want to discuss about the best system for your project and the most adapted fluorophores, mounting medium.. etc.

5) After being trained on the system, you'll be able to book a session. You can use the submit issue button to signal any issue on the system. 

6) Session can be deleted using the delete button after editing the session you want to suppress. Always use the "delete booking record option" when it is possible.

Do not use a system without being trained by somebody from the Imaging Facility. Do not use a system without booking it. Use your own login when you want to book a system
